Counselling Contract

The purpose of this contract is to enable the client and the counsellor to be clear about any agreement between them with regard to practical and ethical issues. I will take you through each point in our first session.

Your counselling appointment is at 2pm each Monday unless otherwise agreed. Each session will cost £45 and is payable on the day of the session by Paypal or bank transfer.

A counselling session lasts 50 minutes and will end promptly. If you arrive late, unfortunately I cannot extend the agreed time.

Your sessions will be held online via Skype. If a remote session is interrupted by a technical connection issue then please wait for me to call you back.

If you need to cancel a session you must give 24 hours notice. If you give less than less than 24 hours notice your fee will still be payable. If you have not joined a session within 20 minutes of the start time, the session will terminate and the fee will still be payable. If you miss two sessions in a row without contact, or if you frequently cancel sessions, your place may be closed. Sessions will not take place if you are under the influence of alcohol or non-prescribed drugs.

Any breaks taken by me, unless by reason of illness or emergency, will be notified at least two weeks in advance.

The number of sessions available is open-ended but I suggest a provisional agreement of 12 sessions with a review after 6 sessions to discuss progress and the possibility of additional sessions if required.

Though sessions will be confidential, I reserve the right to break confidentiality in specific circumstances. (I will explain these to you).

I adhere to the BACP (British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy) Ethical Framework (2018).
